DELEGATIONS OF POWERS AND FUNCTIONS

I, **NICHOLAS PAUL WILSON**, Fair Work Ombudsman, pursuant to subsection 683 of the *Fair Work Act 1996 (Act)*, hereby delegate to each of the staff members and Fair Work Inspectors of the Office of the Fair Work Ombudsman identified in column B of following table the corresponding functions specified in column A of the table.

Disclose, or authorise the disclosure of, information in accordance with s 718(2) of the Act.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fair Work Inspectors • Members of staff • Persons assisting the Fair Work Ombudsman under s 698 • Consultants engaged under s 699 • Persons assisting a Fair Work Inspector under s 710

Disclose, or authorise the disclosure of, information to the Minister in accordance with s 718(3) of the Act.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Members of staff engaged at the Senior Executive Service level
Disclose, or authorise the disclosure of, information to the Department in accordance with s 718(4) of the Act.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Members of staff engaged at the Senior Executive Service level
